Artist of the month - Stacey Gendreau

Stacey Gendreau was raised on a small dairy farm in Ashford, Connecticut, always exploring the natural environment of the 300 acre farm. She has served 23 years in a hospital setting and continues to be a volunteer EMT between Hampton and Chaplin for 27 years. All the while finding her bliss in the world of art. Her fine attention to detail is key whether dealing with a medical emergency or creating a work of art.

"For me my small art studio is at times a place to focus on my art and other times a spiritual sanctuary. When in my studio, working on an art project, the stresses and worries of daily life can gradually fade into the background. At other times, it is a place of solitude, where my soul feels most sharply, the pains and pleasures of life and the tears flow freely. In either case, the experience is cleansing and cathartic and binds me to the earth.

When I paint images of Native Americans and Nature, I feel a closer bond to Mother Earth, and a more harmonious way of living. Long walks alone in the woods ground me and allow me later on to feel one with the wood when working with it. I work with in the parameters of the wood grain to bring out the natural beauty that mother earth has blessed us with. Using reclaimed wood connects me to the people of the past and also gives the wood new life.

The process of designing furniture is one which I truly enjoy. From selecting a piece of wood to conceptualizing how best to utilize its qualities is key for me. I also enjoy using traditional hand tools which brings me closer to the wood rather than using modern power tools. Although I do use some power tools, my emphasis is on hand tools. Traditional woodworking methods such as hand planing wood, hand cut dovetails and joinery are a key component of my furniture building process. I often used reclaimed lumber some of which is approximately 400 yrs old.

I hope people enjoy the beauty of the natural artwork I have created and welcome it into their home."

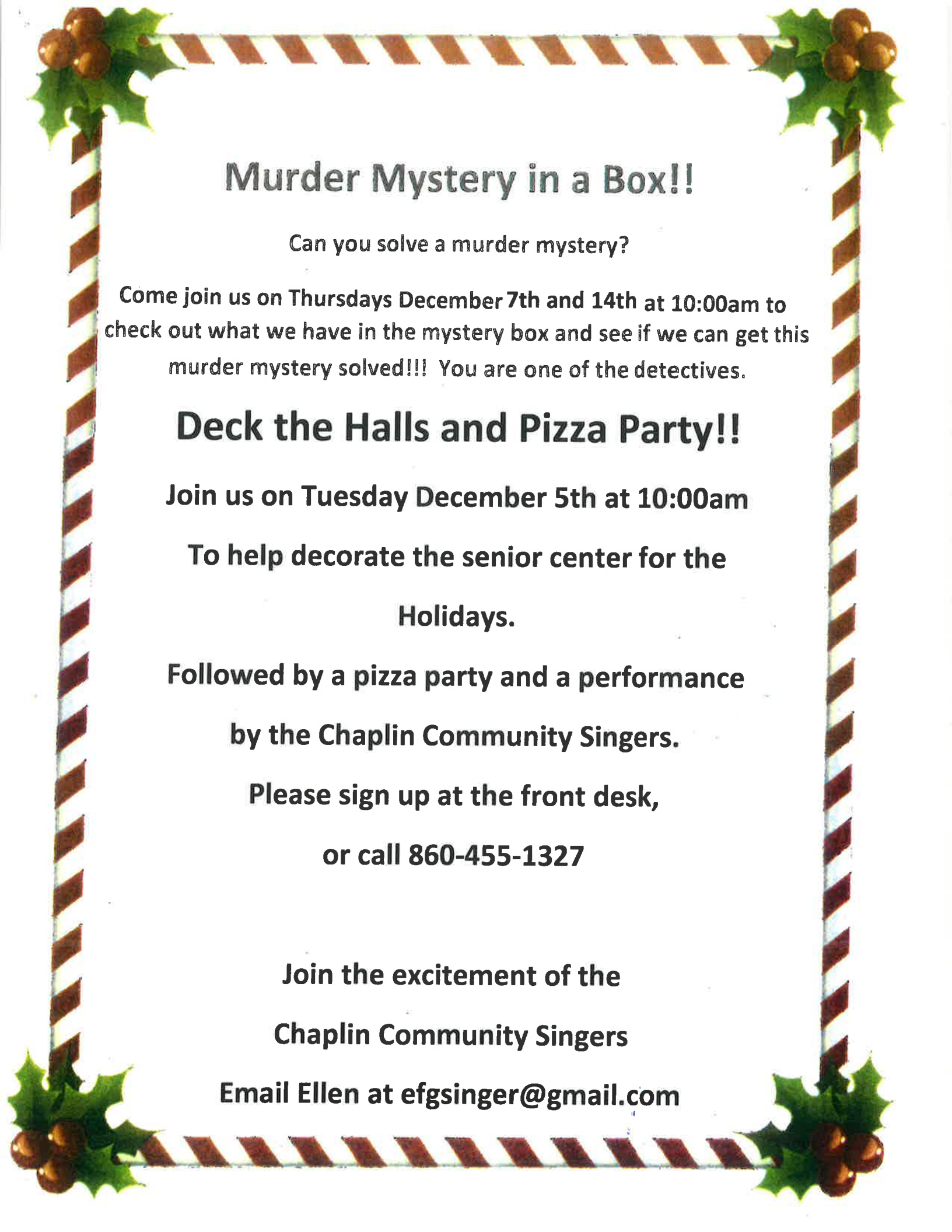
CURBSIDE PICKUP OR DINE IN LUNCHES

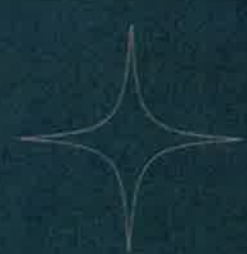

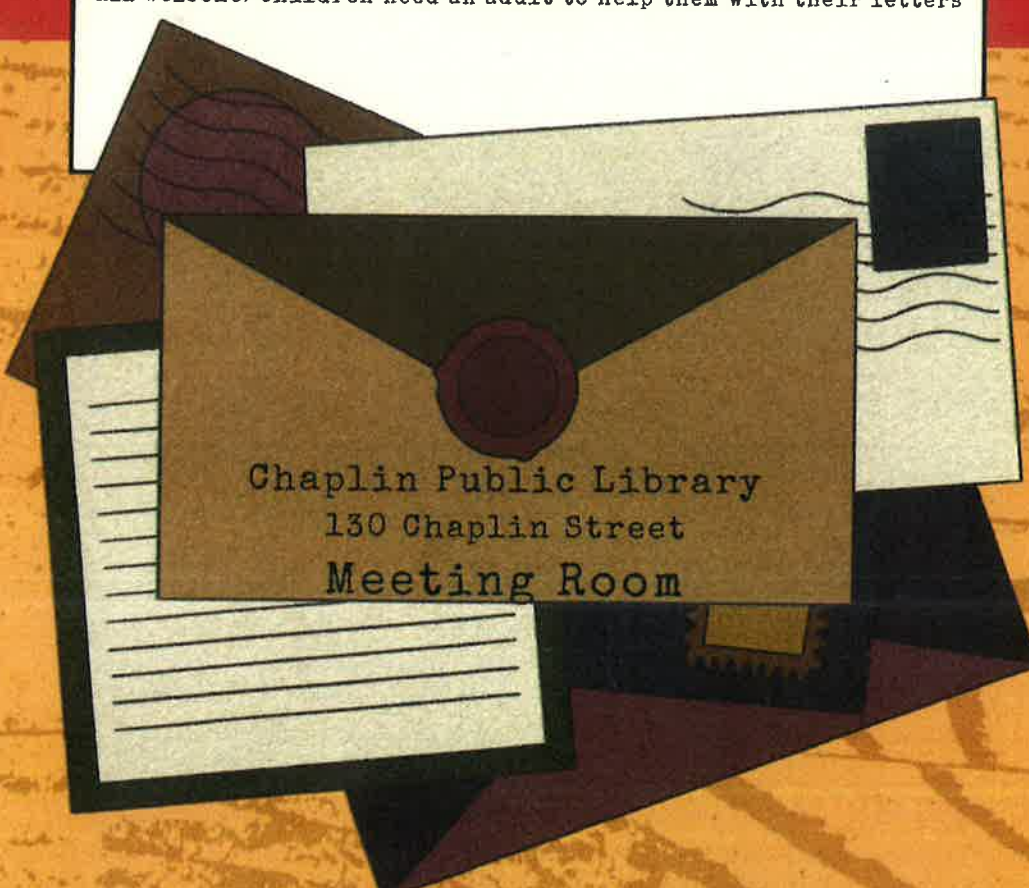

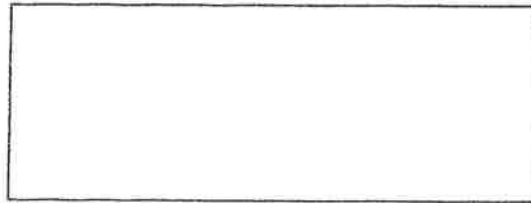
